Stars over Laax at Crap Sogn Gion: Title ruling of the snowboard pros at the LAAX OPEN 2022 on Saturday, 15 January, in Laax, Switzerland

Finals in LAAX. On Saturday, 15 January, the crowning conclusion of the last FIS Snowboard World Cup before the Olympic Games is on the programme with two finals for women and men. In the Slopestyle and in the Halfpipe, prestigious titles, valuable World Cup points, a total of CHF 140,000 in prize money and for some, a ticket to the Olympics is what's at stake.

The Slopestyle finals at midday (1.15 PM) promises nail-biting excitement with overall World Cup winners 2020/21 Anna Gasser (AUT) and Marcus Kleveland (NOR), but also the new breed like Switzerland's Bianca Gisler and Germany's Leon Vockensperger and Annika Morgan. The finale highlight of the LAAX OPEN 2022 is the Superpipe night finale under floodlights (5.30 PM). The start list is chock full of illustrious names, including the US superstars Chloe Kim and Shaun White, the Chinese Jiayu Liu and Cai Xuetong and the impressive Japanese faction, which alone has eight riders in the finals. The host country Switzerland is also well-represented by Jan Scherrer and Pat Burgener.

The LAAX OPEN can be followed on LAAX social media channels. The finals will be broadcast on laax.com/open and time-delayed on Red Bull TV. Television channels such as SRF, RTS, RSI (Switzerland), Eurosport, Olympic Channel and others will be broadcasting the World Cup in Laax.
